1. Receipt of drawings
2. Selection of the 10 most beautiful drawings by the Jury
3. Publication of the 10 most beautiful drawings on the social networks and/or the website and announcement of the opening of the votes
4. Election of the three most beautiful drawings by the Jury (50% of the votes) and the public (50% of the votes)
5. Announcement of competition winners on social networks and the website
6. Withdrawal of prizes in Martigny between 20 and 25 September 2020
7. Exhibition of all the drawings from 20 to 27 September 2020 at the finish site of the UCI Road World Championships in Martigny.

- The competition is open to any natural person residing in Switzerland or abroad, with the exception of members of the Association for the Organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships and their children.
- Minors are authorised to participate with the agreement of their legal representative. In the event of a win, the prize shall be communicated to the minor's legal representative.
- The competition is free of charge and there is no obligation to purchase.
- Participation in the competition results from the submission of the drawings to the Association for the organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships.
- This competition is open from Monday 27 April to Friday 3 July 2020.
- The Association for the Organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships undertakes to process the personal data of participants in strict compliance with the provisions governing data protection.
- By participating in the competition, participants expressly agree that their personal data may be used by the Association for the Organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships for marketing purposes, for the promotion of its offers during and beyond the duration of the competition.
- Each participant may, at any time, ask the Association for the Organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships for access to his/her personal information, or exercise his/her right to correct or delete it.
- Various confidentiality rules apply to all data disseminated or published in order to prevent the publication or disclosure of any information deemed confidential.
- The transmission of personal data to third parties is excluded.
- The winners will be contacted by email.
- If the Association for the Organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships fails to contact the winner within 14 days from the date of the jury's choice, the winner shall be deemed to have forfeited his or her prize and the Association for the Organisation of the 2020 UCI Road World Championships may dispose of it at its discretion.
